

-AT Words

* Ideas for implementation:

-Sing as an echo song - have the children repeat each phrase as you sing

- Bring pictures of -AT words and non-AT words. Have the children choose the picture with an -AT word (When labeling the pictures, make the -AT of those words stand out by printing them in red, while the first letter of the word is in black).

- Laminate cards with various -AT words. Place them face down on the ground. On the wall, place pictures of those -AT words. Instruct each child to hop, hop, hop, and when the music stops they must pick up the card they're standing on and read it. After they read the -AT word, they must place it below the matching picture on the wall.
