- Tent: sing camp songs underneath
- Parachute Lift: at least 2 adults lift child in center of parachute for a "Hip Hip Hooray" toss up! (by pulling back and up on edge of parachute)
- Pass the colors: with children sitting and holding to parachute edge (w/ feet under parachute), pass the parachute edge around in a circle and then switch directions, while singing "Round and round and round..."
- Row your boat: stay in same position (as above activity), hold on tight to parachute edge and move hands in a circular motion with everyone else in group—go slow then fast and switch directions
