Chorister vs. music director or conductor? Music stand height

KISS: Keep it Simple, Sweetie! – look up, smile at people, sing with them, & conduct

Gesture:

- Gesture – conduct with right hand. You may do mirror conducting with left hand (using both hands together). Left hand is also used for other cues but not usually for congregational hymns.
- Patterns: 4/4, 3/4, 2/4, 6/8
- Breathe before singing. Show breath by lifting hands slightly before going into beat pattern.
- Downbeat
- Upbeat
- “Circles” – when you’re lost
- Fermata

Look up and Smile and Sing

Take time to breathe between verses

Rehearse with recording – mini practice conducting hymns in meetings

In a perfect world, the congregation and organist follow the director.

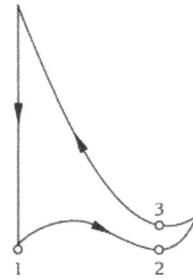

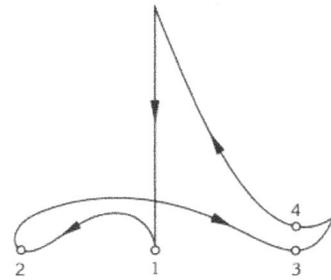

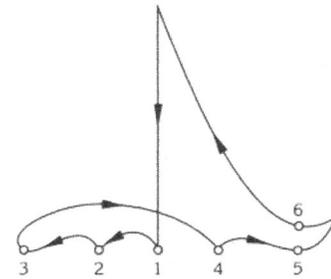
